Text:	No specific text is used.
Supplemental Materials:	Media Center books, magazines and audio-visuals including the genres: adventure stories, autobiographies, biographies, fables, fiction, mysteries, nonfiction, nursery rhymes, plays, poetry, tall tales/folk tales.
Course Description:	To introduce the students to proper book care and appropriate behavior in the Media Center. To instill in them a love of books and appreciation of stories and literature.
Methods of Evaluation:	Students may be evaluated through tests, reports, projects, and teacher observation.
Pace of Instruction:	Students will progress through the curriculum while meeting in the Media Center every other week for a 30 minute period of instruction.
Course Objectives:	At the end of this course students should be able to: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Demonstrate proper care of books2. Locate books of interest using ABC order and check them out properly3. Recognize the parts of a book, including spine, front, back, pages, dust jacket, spine label, author and illustrator.4. Listen to stories read and do activities in conjunction with each story5. Distinguish between fiction (fantasy) and non-fiction (real) books6. Participate in the reading of the Crown Book Award nominees, then vote for their favorite7. Recognize Caldecott Award winning books
