

## PreKindergarten Media

<b>Text:</b>	No specific text is used.
<b>Supplemental Materials:</b>	Media Center books, magazines and audio-visuals including the genres: adventure stories, autobiographies, biographies, fables, fiction, mysteries, nonfiction, nursery rhymes, plays, poetry, tall tales/folk tales.
<b>Course Description:</b>	To introduce the students to proper book care and appropriate behavior in the Media Center To instill in them a love of books and appreciation of stories and literature
<b>Methods of Evaluation:</b>	Students may be evaluated through tests, reports, projects, and teacher observation.
<b>Pace of Instruction:</b>	Students will progress through the curriculum by meeting in the Media Center every other week for a 30 minute period of instruction.
<b>Course Objectives:</b>	At the end of this course students should be able to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Demonstrate proper care of books.</li><li>2. Locate books of interest and check them out properly.</li><li>3. Recognize the parts of a book, including spine, front, back, pages, dust jacket, spine label, author and illustrator.</li><li>4. Listen to stories; read and do activities in conjunction with each story.</li><li>5. Distinguish between fiction (fantasy) and non-fiction (real) books.</li><li>6. Participate in the reading of the Crown Book Award nominees.</li><li>7. Recognize Caldecott Award winning books.</li></ol>
