Read, sing, and play rhythms including eighths, dotted patterns, sixteenths, and syncopated patterns.</li> <li>2. Recognize and perform in <math>\frac{2}{4}</math>, <math>\frac{3}{4}</math>, <math>\frac{4}{4}</math> and <math>\frac{6}{8}</math> meter.</li> <li>3. Read, write, sing, and play ostinatos, duets, partner songs, and chordal harmonies.</li> <li>4. Create their own pieces from speech.</li> <li>5. Improvise on pitched and unpitched instruments, and movements.</li> <li>6. Recognize instruments by sight and sound.</li> <li>7. Sing, play, and listen to music of many styles.</li> <li>8. Use musical terms to describe music.</li> <li>9. Perform from memory speaking, singing, and playing at a level of excellence.</li> </ol>
